WHAT GENETIC CONDITION DO YOU CARRY?

Expanded carrier screening

We all carry some genetic variants without knowing it. An expanded carrier screening test can tell you whether you're a silent carrier for a number of different genetic conditions, to reduce the risk of passing them on to your children.

> Ideally, the test is done before conception, but it can also be prescribed during pregnancy.

Indications

- Ocuples with no specific family history who simply want to reduce the risk of passing on genetic conditions to their children
- ③ An adopted patient or a patient with limited knowledge of their family history
- S Consanguinity in a couple
- Member of a population at risk of carrying specific genetic conditions (e.g., Ashkenazi Jewish ancestry, patient from the Charlevoix/Saguenay-Lac-Saint-Jean region)

What you need to know

Selection of a gamete donor with silent genetic conditions



Number of genes tested: Approximately 603 genes associated with recessive and X linked conditions.



Procedure: Blood test*, available at all our clinics.

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Prescription: Can be prescribed for clinic patients by their fertility specialist, but also available with a prescription from an outside doctor.



Wait time: 10-21 calendar days to get the results.
